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### Woodford Neighbourhood Forum Questionnaire

### Introduction

Woodford Neighbourhood Forum<sup>\*</sup> (WNF) was formed to encourage responsible development in Woodford whilst protecting the Green Belt. The application for the Neighbourhood Area was largely based on the boundary of the parish of Woodford, which has existed since 1873. However, Stockport Council (SMBC) decided to exclude the BAE site from the Neighbourhood Area even though Woodford village is the only link between this development site and the borough of Stockport. This has resulted in an anomalous situation, which we hope will be resolved in the future.

This WNF Questionnaire is intended to seek Woodford residents' views on future developments in the area up to 2030. It is the first stage in the development of a Woodford Neighbourhood Plan (WNP). This plan, when completed and validated by a referendum of residents on the extended electoral role, will become the policy statement for the future development of the village.

At this point WNF only has responsibility for the current Woodford Neighbourhood Area and NOT the BAE site, despite it being a major development site and indeed the only brownfield site currently within the parish of Woodford with a current planning application. Moreover, at present, the only proposed access to the site is via the two entrances on Chester Road in the heart of the village, thus its development is inextricably linked to the future Neighbourhood Plan for Woodford. The result is that any responses or opinions on actual developments within the BAE site cannot form part of the Woodford Neighbourhood Plan unless the Neighbourhood Area is modified. However, any information gathered regarding this can usefully be used by WNF in representing residents in negotiation with Harrow, or other developers, and the SMBC officers responsible for that area.

In order to ensure a common baseline for answering the questions below, please assume that the following major developments<sup>†</sup> will take place and may have significant impact on Woodford.

- 1. The A6 to Manchester Airport Relief Road will be completed and operational by 2018
- 2. The BAE site will be redeveloped resulting in a minimum of 850 new dwellings over a period of 15 years
- 3. Access to the BAE site will be solely from the centre of Woodford by modification to the existing two entrances

<sup>\*</sup> A Neighbourhood Forum has statutory and recognised powers and duties that bring some of the decision-making and liaison closer to those affected by development proposals and allow their views to carry much more weight.

Working within the National Planning Policy Framework, Local Core Strategy and Allocations Plan, Woodford Neighbourhood Forum may produce a Neighbourhood Plan for the designated Area, which would provide guidance for development within that Area and better reflect the views and concerns of local people, businesses and organisations. It cannot change anything that has already been agreed, but can influence future developments. The Plan would have to be submitted to a local referendum in which all registered voters in the Neighbourhood Plan Area would be entitled to vote and can only be accepted if a majority of those voting agree to it. If accepted, the Plan would become a Policy Document to which SMBC must give due consideration.


