## 6. **WNF AGM** 6.1. Nomination forms, mail chimp invitations etc JC reported that high read rate of 60% on the newsletter sent out to all members and non-members on circulation list. Cllrs MP have been forwarding the message. Nomination received to date from NH and JS. Deadline is 16 Sep for receipt of nominations by EF. 7. **CEC Local Plan update** 7.1. Registration, written statement etc PG reported that the Inspector is reopening the Examination and has set dates for procedural meetings. There may be a legal challenge to the procedure. Game changed by previous evidence. What is status of previous evidence? Can submit another 3,000 words. No appendices. Developers not happy. PG and JK will attend procedural meeting, EF possibly. WNF wish to submit statement. Wish to support Green Belt assessment. Highways people say must build new junction from Handforth East onto A555. Timescales are a problem: Likely to be 2021 before any houses could be built. Couldn't build 2,000 houses by 2030. The original justification was a sustainable alternative to Poynton and other areas but now they are proposing to do both. Inspector is reserving his right to make judgement on whether the new material is fit to allow examination to on move on to consider individual sites. Proposal for additional Green Belt around Crewe has been scrapped. Procedural meeting is 6 Sep. Examination to resume 21 Oct. EF EF to register by filling in questionnaire on email by deadline of 14 Sep. WNF to prepare and submit statement. Harrow and Redrow liaison meetings 8. **Redrow meeting** EF reported that Carl Taylor had sent a message requesting confirmation that we were EF all set for meeting on 22 Sep. EF to confirm. Harrow meeting. RBB reported that the majority of buildings are now down. Harrow had handed a section over to Redrow. Harrow trying to buy Bodycote. Likely to succeed. Don't know what they will do with it, but a likely option was demolition. TB reported some areas being converted back into Green Belt. Some big buildings down still to come down. Progress with round-a-bout construction: BL reported than all staff diverted to fill hole in Mancunian Way 9. AOB 9.1 Redrow amendment to planning application. WWMCC and WCC were consulted about Redrow planning app (which involves JS/JC moving things around, minor adjustments). JC or JS to scan letter and circulate. 1 9.2 Vulcan flight Not flying over on 18 Oct . Trying to raise £75K for fuel. Oct 10 and 11 another fly around. Woodford raised the most money. For family and friends test of all kit and fly over by some aircraft. Oct 16<sup>th</sup> is public opening. At present Harrow take everyone's name and money on entry which will be a problem for opening day. VIP opening Oct 8<sup>th</sup> run by BAE, Sir John Masefield will attend [open?] the event.
